- Deliver High-Quality Instruction: Teach engaging and effective ski or snowboard lessons to guests of varying ages and abilities, tailoring lessons to individual learning styles.
- **Safety First**: Prioritize the safety of students, guests, and coworkers by following Rabbit Hill's safety guidelines and protocols.

- Availability to work the full winter season (November through March), including weekends, evenings, and holidays.
- Professional demeanor with a commitment to providing exceptional guest experiences.
- Ability to work well with children, youth, and adults.
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills.
- Adaptability to varying guest needs and changing work environments.
- Previous teaching or coaching experience is an asset but not required.
- Willingness to learn and participate in continuous training.

# **Working Conditions**

- Physically demanding, outdoor role in all winter weather conditions.
- Exposure to risks inherent in skiing and snowboarding, including slips, falls, and collisions.
- Long periods of standing, riding, walking, and manual labor.
- Frequent reaching, kneeling, bending, twisting, pushing, pulling, and lifting.
- Working in loud, crowded, fast-paced environments.
- Navigating varied terrain, including snowy, icy, hard-packed, or wet conditions.
