Summary

The Snowmaking Crew lead will supervise and lead the snowmaking team. They will be accountable for carrying out assignments from the Snowmaking Manager. This includes making quality snow in the highest volumes possible by learning and understanding the snowmaking process. Snowmakers will be responsible for operating and maintaining various pieces of equipment, such as snow guns, pumps, and generators.

Job Duties

- Supervise, coordinate, and manage snowmaking teams
- Maintaining, moving, and positioning snow guns and managing the snowmaking systems pumps and compressors
- Set up and take down equipment
- Transfer snow guns and hoses to different locations around the hill
- Complete daily checks, maintain snow guns and equipment

- Keep a record of snowmaking details
- Address any safety concerns which would put any employee in an unsafe situation
- Assist in all emergency situations
- Follow all policies and procedures as set out by management
- Know and follow all safety procedures without exception
- Safely use vehicles such as snowmobiles, quads, and side-by-sides
- Shovel and clear ice
- Roll and pack hoses
- Using tools such as propane torches
- Other duties as required

Requirements

- Must be at a minimum of 18 years of age
- Must have a valid class 5 driver's license and have own reliable transportation
- Ability to drive a quad is an asset
- Physically capable and able to lift up to 50 lbs
- Ability and desire to work outdoors (day or night) in winter, in all weather conditions
- Able to work various, round the clock shifts
- May be required to work extended hours, including weekends and statutory holidays
- Previous experience supervising or leading a team is an asset
- Self-confident, reliable, and a quick learner
- Able to work alone or with others in a team environment
- Mechanically inclined
- Self-motivated, responsible, and willing to learn
- Able to work around buildings and structures in a safe manner
- Prior experience in a related field, an asset
- Must be able to start work in September and work until near Christmas. There is potential to work in another department for the remainder of the season for the right person.

Working Conditions

- Physically demanding job
- Manual dexterity required to use equipment and hand tools.
- Extended periods of standing and walking
- Reaching, kneeling, bending, twisting, pulling, pushing, and lifting
- Working at night
- Outdoor work in extreme winter conditions.
- Working on variable terrain such as snowy, hard, icy, and wet surfaces
- Working around machinery such as snow cats, snowmobiles, and side-by-sides
- Working with potentially hazardous tools and equipment
